



	<p>I went to Paws In The Park to see how my tax money was being spent. She had told me the OSPCA was running it, and the OSPCA is given \$260,000 a year to do animal control and because the Town has staff to do promotions and more staff to advertise and more staff to do Bylaws that my money was likely going to be wasted. But I wanted to photo document it for others to see the waste,</p>	<p>All photos are available for viewing in full size at: REDACTED</p>	<p>4) On Saturday June 3rd 2017, I attended the Park, known as Sheppard's Bush in the Town of Aurora, just off of Industrial Parkway South, to oversee an event being run by the OSPCA on behalf of the Town of Aurora's By-Law Division called "Paws in the Park".</p>	<p>12:44:33 ME: Everything kind of escalated with him when we ran an event in the town of Aurora "Paws in the Park". <u>(BL: Actually, the OSPCA ran it, not the Town, as she had told me previously... she cannot seem to keep her story straight on even who ran the event...)</u> March 28 8:29 Hi Bob, Yes I am a dog owner and have had dogs all my life. Paws in the Park is being taken over by OSPCA this year. Mandie Crawford)</p>
			<p>5) I had advised my staff of officers that I would be there for about 2 hours - between one and three o'clock. <u>(BL: It was scheduled for 10am-2pm)</u></p>	<p>people come out and bring their animals and learn about some of the bylaws and see some of the officers. So I scheduled to be there a couple of hours. <u>(BL: Later in the interview, she says it was supposed to be her day off)</u> - I let my guys run it. This is the first year my guys have done it on their own <u>(BL: She previously stated the OSPCA ran it this year. I said "No harm was done."</p>		<p>18) Within about one to two minutes, two dogs came running from my right, around the front end of the cruiser and approached myself, the YRP Officer and the police dog. 19) I noticed right away that the two dogs were tied together with some sort of harness.</p> <p>20) No one was with the dogs. (BL: I was right in front of her speaking to the K9 Constable Batchelar) The dogs approached and one went one direction around my legs and the other went around the other side of me. I was speaking to the YRP Officer when the dogs arrived. 21) I believe that the one dog was also entangled in Michelle Wacker's feet as well. (BL: Wacker does NOT CONFIRM this statement. She cannot decide whether it was FEET or LEGS on Wacker which were entangled. 	I start to leave, someone says "Your dog pooped" and I go back a step, a lady offers me a bag, but I get a bag out and clean it up. I move south and pick up my camera and walk west to the fence around the large soccer field.		24) I felt as if I was going to fall as a result of being tangled in the leash. 25) I believe I repeated myself asking whose dogs these were.		
			26) I saw someone trying to reach for the 'handle' of the harness to get control of the dogs, 27) and saw the YRP Officer grab his canine companion to take it to the other side of his police vehicle, away from the confusion.		
			28) This took place over about 10 seconds, and the scene to me appeared very chaotic. 29) I estimated the time to be about 12:40 pm. 30) I managed to step out of the loop of leashes that was around my legs and looked up to my right and observed a male known to me as Bob Lepp. (BL: I was RIGHT IN FRONT OF HER SPEAKING TO K9 Const. BATCHELAR.)		
			31) Mr. Lepp grabbing (grabbed?) at the dogs. 32) I had seen him moments earlier behind the rear of the police vehicle setting up or working on a camera he had.		
			33) In the confusion I noted that the dogs had knocked the tripod at the rear corner panel of the police vehicle and the tripod looked as if it was crooked and about to fall.		
			34) Once I saw that Mr. Lepp had control of the animals, I called to him and reminded him that his dogs had to be on leash and 'under control'.		And at that point I looked over and saw Mr. Lepp (BL: NO. I was between her and the K9 officer, right in front of her, she need not "look over" at all. I have a photograph of where she and officer Wacker stood in relation to the K9 officer and myself as I walked up to speak to the K9 officer about Google Maps.) and I recognized him as Bob Lepp. I said "Mr. Lepp you know better you can't have your dogs off leash especially around the canine police dog sitting here you can't do that and you could be ticketed for something like that" (BL: No. She yelled out that my dogs were a problem for her, and I asked "What harm have they done?" And she said "The K9 officer had to put his dog away.")
			35) I mentioned that the incident could have been dangerous and he could be ticketed for dog at large. 36) Mr. Lepp looked directly at me and said something to the effect of "I'd like to see you try".		12:46:18 And he made some snide comment about "I'd like to see you try." (BL: No, I said "You could?" when she stated "I could give you a ticket right now for that.")

37) I turned and walked towards our town display tent, still trying to process what had happened. (BL: I turned south and west and started photographing the soccer pitch surface.)

I thought about it for a minute and I thought I'm not going to fall for this kind of thing. But then I...when I walked back to the table I thought it would really have been a serious incident because **the canine officer had to grab his dog and threw him in the vehicle**

(BL: No, the officer led his dog away from the shouting and the dog leaped into the unit) and it could have been a real problem.

(BL: How exactly?)

Plus the fact you know I could've been tripped and the way it wrapped around us.

(BL: She said she just "I kind of stepped out" of it. There was no tangling. If she was tangled, she could not "just step out", that would be the very definition of "NOT being tangled")

(BL: RIGHT NOW in the Provincial Offenses disclosure, she added in 5 minutes right here wherein I walked around, and I was pulling my dogs even though one was stooped to poop, and my dog pooped, and I only picked up one piece, a complete extra five minutes of time that never happened. Here, in her criminal charges witness interview, that whole 5 minutes disappeared and she eliminates 20 minutes of time between 12:40 "talking to K9 officer" to 12:59 "ticket stuck in bag"...by making it sound like she just wrote up a ticket in seconds. I, in the meantime, took a series of 36 photos of the entire large soccer field artificial turf between 12:40 and 13:59 showing exactly where I was and what I was doing.)

(BL: In her bylaw disclosure, she said she had to go find a ticket book, probably because she could not get her officers to ticket me.)


